The 5 PearlZ Scholarship Program will award five \$1,000 scholarships to assist with educational expenses. The program aims to honor African American female high school seniors, who exhibit personal integrity and excellence through academic achievement and community involvement. The recipient may complete their studies in the field of their choice at any post-secondary institution.

Application Deadline: January 16, 2025 **Award Announcement:** February 2025

Award: \$1000

Eligibility Requirements

- Must be an African American female senior student residing in and attending a Planning District 16 Area high school (City of Fredericksburg and the Counties of Caroline, King George, Spotsylvania, and Stafford).
- Must be graduating in May/June (Spring) of the award year and enrolling as a full-time student in an accredited post-secondary institution in the fall of the same year.
- Must have a minimum 2.5 GPA on a 4.0 scale.
- Must show involvement in community service.
- Applications and supporting documents received after January 16th will not be considered for an award. Partial Submissions will not be accepted.
